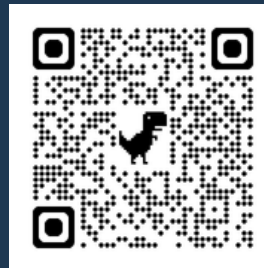

Workshop 1
